Dissolution

Benson Community Association is proposing to wind up and pass its assets, including Warwick Spinney, to a new charity called Benson Community Green Space Trust, a charitable incorporated organisation (CIO). The new CIO has now been registered by the Charity Commission with charity number 1186960. To complete the winding up process the trustees of the existing charity will need to transfer the charity's assets to the CIO.

The decision to transfer the assets needs to be confirmed by those voting members of Benson Community Association and the inhabitants of the Parishes of Benson and Berrick Salome and the neighbourhood who are aged 18 or over.
